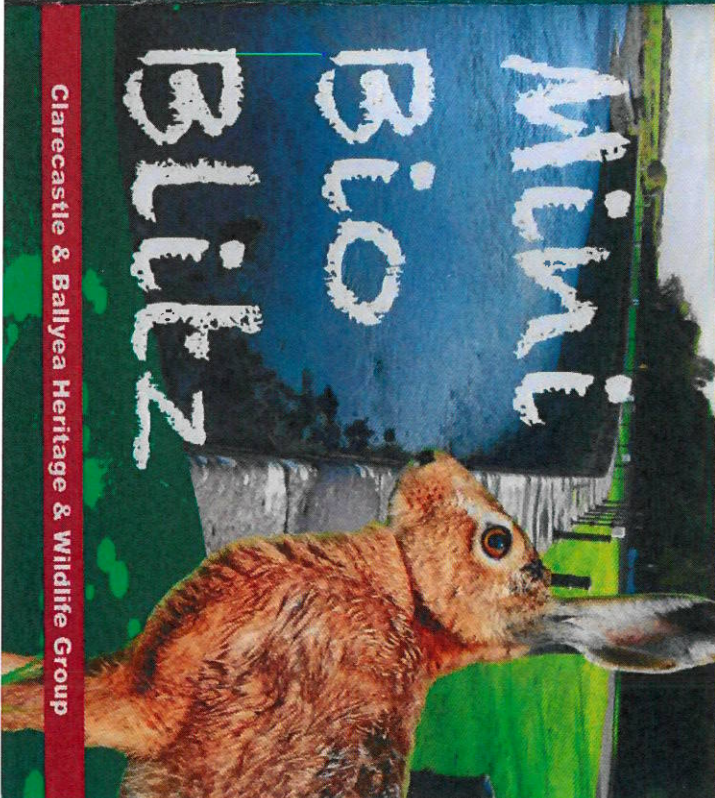

- * Dispose of waste properly.

- * Minimise the effects of fire – no smoking – it could easily start a scrub fire.

- * Respect animals & wildlife. Be quiet and calm
- * Be considerate of others.
- * Supervise children at all times.

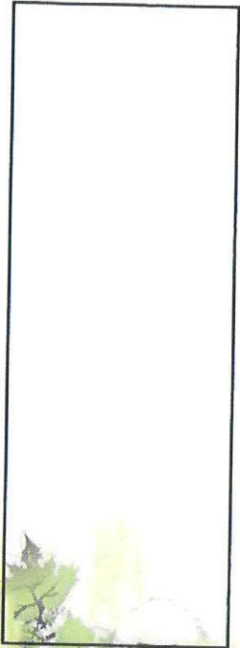

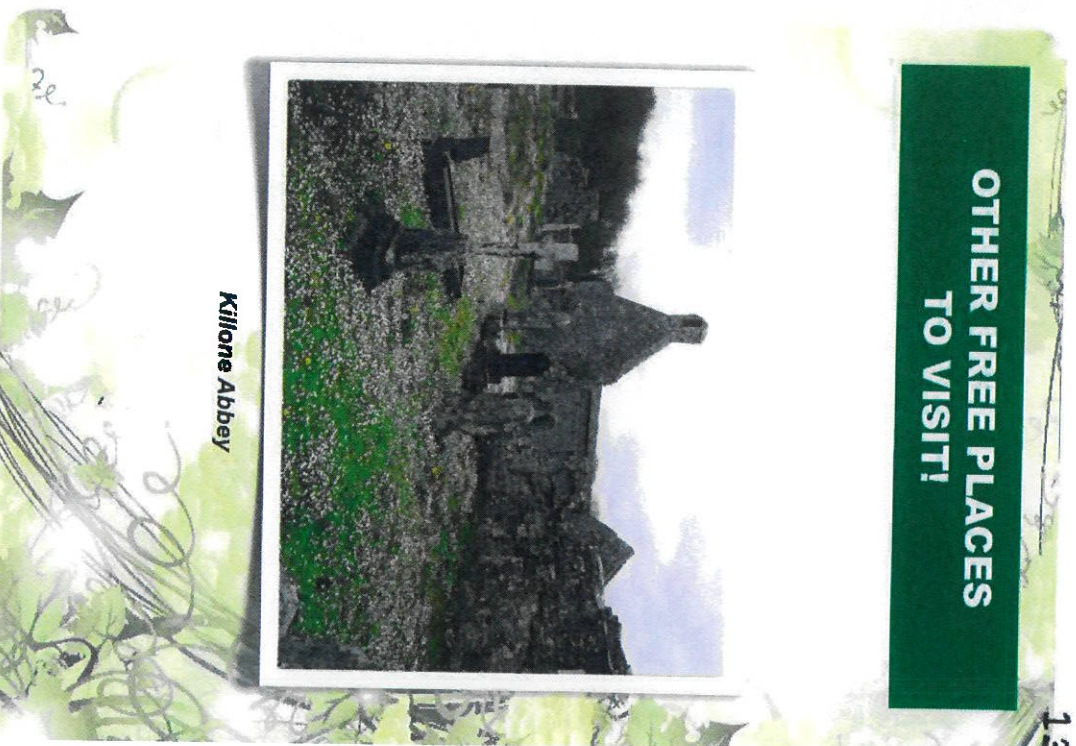
