

## Revision/cancelled books Clareabbey/Clarecastle parish 1855-1970

The parish of Clareabbey, now called Clarecastle, has twenty-three townlands.

When the Primary (Griffith) Valuation for County Clare was published in 1855, the information included all townlands in each parish, which was the case with Clareabbey. Clareabbey also included an entity called Islands which is not a townland but counted a number of islands in the River Fergus including the military barracks of Clare Castle.

However, when the revision/cancelled books were developed to update information in the original valuation, these were recorded by townland in district electoral divisions (DED). Clarecastle townlands are located across three DED; Clareabbey, Doora and Killone, as listed below.
